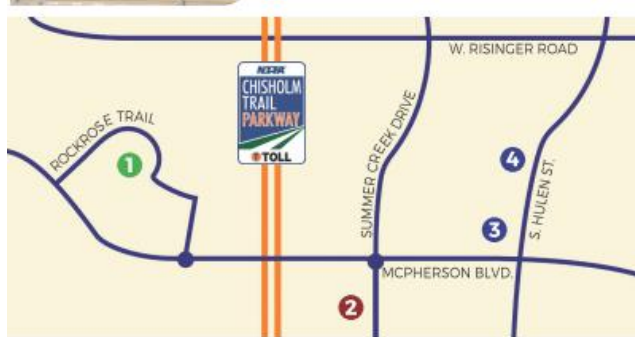

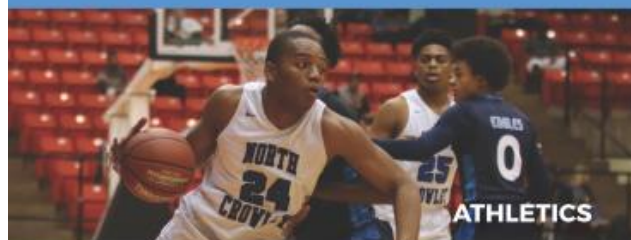

**FULL-DAY PRE-KINDERGARTEN**
